- Casting temperature of up to 1550 °C: ideal for all commercially available dental alloys (except titanium)
- Quick adjustment to different sizes of casting rings using a simple mechanism



The design – ergonomic and compact

The Fornax[®] T functions have been valued by users for many years: an ergonomic, compact centrifugal casting machine with all the technical and economic advantages.

The advantages for you:

- The low overall height means that a lower workbench is no longer required
- There is sufficient space on any laboratory bench for the unit
- A standard, fused Schuko socket is all that is required to make the machine ready to use immediately

Integrated power cooling system

The Fornax® boasts integrated power cooling.

The advantages for you:

- More than 50 casts in a row are possible with moulds made from phosphate-bonded investment material, even if ambient temperatures are high
- Does not require a water supply or water outlet can be used immediately anywhere
- No water consumption, no water damage and no reliance on local water quality
- Furthermore, the costs of installing an expensive water system are saved
- Since the unit does not require a water supply, condensation forming on the crucible coil in the winter months, "explosions", mould cracks and the resulting flawed casts are no longer a concern

The technology in detail

Fornax[®] T has a very powerful induction heating of 3,600 VA.

The advantages for you:

- Rapid heating and melting of all commercially available precious and non-precious alloys (except titanium)
- Sufficient power reserves even with critical alloys
- Oxidation is minimised to the absolute necessary due to rapid melting to the casting temperature and facilitates trimming at a later stag

BEGO has developed a special crucible safety base for optimal protection of your machine during the casting procedure.

The advantages for you:

- If the crucible fails, the molten metal will be safely collected in the ceramic safety base
- This effectively prevents any serious damage to the machine

In addition to timing the casting point, the multi-functional display also shows the service notification and enables help to be obtained quickly when servicing is required.

Simple handling

The counterweight is very easily set using an adjustment mechanism with a toothed segment that has predefined markings for different sizes of casting rings.

The advantages for you:

- Adjustment to the correct size of casting ring in a matter of seconds ensures effective operation
- The tare unit is self locking and does not need to be fixed in position separately



Constant further development of the ceramic crucibles ensures optimal castings

The ceramic crucibles for Fornax[®] casting machines in original BEGO quality provide you with **many advantages**:

- Excellent thermal shock resistance up to 1,500 °C, which minimises the risk of splitting
- Special geometry ensures that alloys flow optimally
- The integrated crucible protection reduces casting residue in the crucible for cost-effective casting
- The smooth, high-grade surfaces also emphasise the high quality of the crucible and provide it with a perfect finish
